San Francisco Business Women Raise Awareness of Domestic Violence

San Francisco, CA – April 16, 2007 – Today, Soroptimist International of San Francisco announced a citywide Domestic Violence Awareness Poster Contest. Any student in grades 9 through 12 can enter. The winner will receive a check for \$250.00. The winner's school or alternatively a non-profit organization of choice will also receive a check for \$250.00. The winning poster will be widely publicized Bay Area wide.

All entries for the contest must be received by Friday, May 11, 2007 – only one entry per person. In order to participate, students are asked to create a poster in color with colored pencils, paint or gel pens, etc., on a plain white sheet of paper that is at least 8 ½ x 11 inches, but no larger than 16 x 20 inches. Send or deliver your poster and entry form by May 11, 2007 to: Soroptimist c/o MG West on 611 Mission St. 3rd Floor in San Francisco, CA 94105. All valid entries must be accompanied by an attached entry form that includes the following information: First Name, Last Name, grade in school, mailing address, and e-mail address if available, your school's name, address, and principal's name. The entry must further contain the following statement signed by a parent: "I understand the poster contest rules, and hereby grant the Soroptimist International of San Francisco or their assignees permission to use my child's artwork from the Domestic Violence Awareness Poster Contest for the purpose of illustration, publication or broadcast.

Note: All entries become the property of the San Francisco Soroptimists. Posters cannot be returned. The artwork may be released for use by television, newspaper, magazine or other media outlets including the Web/Internet/Intranet or for promotional or marketing purposes at the discretion of the Soroptimists.
